

## Love Albania 2022 Cycling and Service Tour – Summary Sheet

<i>Saturday, May 21</i>	Cyclists arrive in Tirana P.M.	
<i>Sunday, May 22</i>	Bicycle setup and orientation in Tirana	
<i>Monday, May 23</i>	Depart early morning drive Tirana to Vlore, meet Albanian cyclists in Vlore, and cycle 71 km from Vlore to Himare	
<i>Tuesday, May 24</i>	Cycle 51 km from Himare to Sarande	Service team participants arrive in the afternoon in Tirana. Welcome and logistics.
<i>Wednesday, May 25</i>	Cycle 55 km from Sarande to Gjirokaster. Shared evening cultural activity with service team.	Scenic drive through Albanian countryside to Gjirokaster. Shared evening cultural activity with cycling team.
<i>Thursday, May 26</i>	Bus transfer from Gjirokaster to Permet then cycle 64 kilometers from Permet to the Farma Sotiri campground.	Bus transfer through the mountains from Gjirokaster to Korce stopping at several scenic locations. Korce activity orientation, volunteer opportunities, and signup.
<i>Friday, May 27</i>	Cycle 70 kilometers from Farma Sotiri Campground to Korce. 8:00 P.M. tour completion celebration at the Vog Bar Café with service team, cycling team families and other community members.	Prayer and morning tour of Korce and outlying villages of Dardhe, Boboshtica, and Devoran followed by meeting with community leaders to understand their heart for Korce. 8:00 P.M. celebration at the Vog Bar Café with cycling team members, their families, and community members.
<i>Saturday, May 28</i>	Cycle 40 kilometer roundtrip to Voskopoje from Korce with children and veterans from the Korce area. Picnic at Voskopoje. Optional attendance at NOVO training in late afternoon/evening	Prayer walk orientation leading into urban prayer walk in Korce followed by community picnic in village of Voskopoje to understand the local heart for the villages. Visits in family homes in the afternoon and evening. Optional attendance at NOVO training in late afternoon/evening
<i>Sunday, May 29</i>	Cycling team divides out to three churches in the Korce area – the Korce Evangelical Church, Emmanuel Church in Korce (primarily a gypsy congregation), and the Evangelical Church in Pojan village. Church service is followed by a typical outdoor barbeque with church and community members and their families. Optional attendance at NOVO training in late afternoon/evening.	Service team divides out to three churches in the Korce area – the Korce Evangelical Church, Emmanuel Church in Korce (primarily a gypsy congregation), and the Evangelical Church in Pojan village. Church service is followed by a typical outdoor barbeque with church and community members and their families. Optional attendance at NOVO training in late afternoon/evening.
<i>Monday, May 30</i>	Drive from Korce to Pogradec and then cycle 90 km counterclockwise around Lake Ohrid. Route goes into Macedonia. We will make various scenic/historic stops on the way. Upon return to Korce, cyclists pack their bicycles and make an evening departure to drive from Korce to a Tirana airport hotel.	On these next three days, the service team will be able to choose each day from a variety of activities including community service projects to be determined, visits with local families, leaders, and groups, and work at a feeding program for local gypsy children. This will be a great opportunity to build relationships with community leaders, families, affinity group leaders (including local cycling, hunting, fishing, and cooking groups), and serve some of the poorest members in the community. Each day you will have the option to attend the NOVO training in the late afternoon/evening.
